**Investment Message:** Through programs like ESL classes,  
food ministry, health expos at libraries, public spaces, and  
mosques, Citizenship classes at libraries and public spaces,  
Bible study classes, individually and in groups, Job  
placement assistance, and Bible studies (training recent  
converts to assist). The Muslim refugees in San Diego have
