**Investment message:** In the Bible, we see many examples of God bringing people into partnership with Himself to see His will and purposes accomplished on earth. One great example of this is Moses: God was going to deliver the children of Israel, but it was not going to happen without Moses. Moses was quite reluctant to accept this commission; and who could blame him? When he asked God how he could possibly accomplish this task, God simply said, “I will certainly be with you” (verse 12). Moses *couldn’t* do it without God, but God chose not to do it without Moses. They would fulfill this mission in partnership. This is how God accomplishes His will on earth. He finds yielded vessels who will surrender to Him and partner with Him to see His kingdom come. We have the privilege of laboring with God to see His purposes accomplished.
