Now he's turned his hobby into several Investment projects. One of his friends collects large table-sized spools which the city discards after installing electrical cables. He removes the plywood and gives it to Bill. Bill uses the plywood and other supplies to fashion bird houses, key racks, footstools, and other things. Bill also uses his lathe to turn out wooden bowls with a built-in pedestal and then makes covers to match. Bill takes the finished pieces to stores.
