Seminar: Christ's Method Alone by Philip Samaan this afternoon, 2-6 p.m. at Central SDA Church, 5 N. Skinker Blvd. St. Louis 63105. Dr. Philip Samaan is a theology professor at Southern Adventist University. Prior to this he served as the chief editor of the Adult Sabbath School Lessons at the General Conference, and as a professor both in the Religion Department and the Theological Seminary at Andrews University.
