Seminar: *Christ’s Method Alone* by Philip Samaan this afternoon, 2-6 p.m. at Central SDA Church, 5 N. Skinker Blvd. St. Louis 63105. Dr. Philip Samaan is a theology professor at Southern Adventist University. Prior to this he served as the chief editor of the Adult Sabbath School Lessons at the General Conference, and as a professor both in the Religion Department and the Theological Seminary at Andrews University. While at the Theological Seminary, he also served as director of the Doctor of Ministry program, the Center for Continuing Education for Ministry, and the M.A. in Pastoral Ministry. Among his published works are the books *Blood Brothers*, *Portraits of the Messiah*, *Christ’s Way to Pray*, *Christ’s Way of Reaching People*, *Christ’s Way to Spiritual Growth*, *Christ’s Way of Making Disciples*, *Christ’s Way to Restoration*, and *Christ’s Way of Affirmation*, *Christ’s Method Alone*, *Abraham’s Other Son*, and *Dare to Be a Daniel*.
